- Basic Technician Certificate (NTA Level 4), Entry qualification, Holder of Certificate of secondary education examination (CSEE) with four (4) Passes in non-religious subjects including 'D' passes in Physics, Chemistry and Biology.
- Technician Certificate (NTA Level 5), Entry Qualification, holder of Certificate of secondary education examination (CSEE) with four (4) Passes in non-religious subjects including 'D' passes in Physics, Chemistry and Biology; AND Possession of Basic Technician Certificate (NTA Level 4).
- Ordinary Diploma - Basic Technician Certificate in related Course (NTA Level 4), Entry qualification, Holder of Certificate of secondary education examination (CSEE) with four passes in non-religious subjects including 'D' passes in Physics, Chemistry and Biology

Holder of Certificate of secondary education examination (CSEE) with four passes in non-religious subjects including 'D' passes in Physics, Chemistry and Biology and Possession of Technician Certificate in Related course.

1. Confirmation

You should confirm your acceptance to join the college before By effecting payment of training fee to the College Bank Accounts and bring/send the bank pay in slip to the college so that your name will be registered in the confirmed student's list.

Note: Failure to confirm before or by the mentioned date by submitting the pay in slip to the Bursar/Accountant; another candidate will fill your position.

2. Reporting and Registration

2.1. You should report to the college on

2.2. You should report during working hours; from 8:00 am to 4:00 p.m.

2.3. On arrival, you will be required to prove to the bursar/Accountant that you have paid the fees by showing the original pay in slip to the College Accountant. Failure to that you will not be accepted to join the college.

2.4. Read the whole instructions carefully. You will only be allowed to register for studies after fulfilling the requirements as indicated in all sections of the joining instructions.

3. Accommodation and Meals

4. Training Fee Applicable for the Academic Year 2026/2027

4.1. There should be an unavoidable circumstance that would require revision of fees; they may be revised from time to time without prior notice.

4.2 Revised fee structure will be applicable to the new intake as well as for continuing students.

4.3 Fees are payable in full at the beginning of each year or into four installments

4.4 No student will be allowed to carry forward part of the fee into the following installment, semester or academic year.

4.5 The training fee will not be refunded or exchanged to another student's bill after a student has been registered with the college.

5. Schedule of Training Fee Payment by four (4) Installments per year.

- i. Tsh.375,000/= The first date of the beginning first Semester (October-1st Quarter)
- ii. Tsh.375,000/= After three months after 1st Semester (January- 2nd Quarter)
- iii. Tsh.375,000/= The 1st date of beginning 2nd Semester (April- 3rd Quarter)
- iv. Tsh.375,000/= After three months after 2nd semester (July - 4th Quarter)

6. Additional College Requirements.

6.1 Original Certificates
